Collective Bargaining Agreement: National Employment Council for Electronics, Communications,

COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT:
Further Agreement

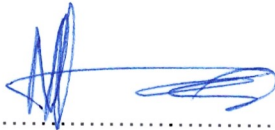

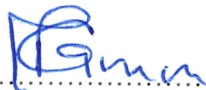
